**Election information: Vote!**

**Tuesday, November 4<sup>th</sup> is the State Election.  
The polls in Granby will be open from 7:00 a.m. - 8:00 p.m.**

**Going out of town for the election? You may file an absentee ballot. Last day to file will be Monday, November 3<sup>rd</sup>, at 12:00 noon.**

**Specimen ballots are posted at the Granby Town Hall Annex, C.O.A., East Meadow School, Dressel's Service Station, the Granby Post Office, Public Library and the town website [www.granby-ma.gov](http://www.granby-ma.gov)**

**Precinct 1- (Third Hampshire District) has only the four state questions.**

**Precinct 2 (Second Hampshire District) has five questions on the ballot the four State Questions, and a Non-Binding question.**

**Question 5**

**THIS QUESTION IS NOT BINDING**

**(SECOND HAMPSHIRE DISTRICT ONLY-PRECINCT 2)**

**Shall the state representative from this district be instructed to vote for legislation that replaces the state's restrictions on marijuana with a law that regulates the cultivation of and commerce in marijuana, by persons over the age of 21, in the same manner as laws that apply to retail and agricultural businesses; such as a law would (i) require persons covered by the law to take steps to prevent access to growing plants and marijuana by minors under the age of 18, (ii) punish distribution among and to such minors, (iii) retain for minors the civil offense of possessing one ounce or less of marijuana, and (iv) make no change to existing laws regarding driving while under the influence?**

**Please make sure your voting status is current:**

**If you did not answer your 2014 Town Census, or voted in the last four years you may be off the active voting list.**

**If you registered through the registry of motor vehicles and never received an acknowledgement notice from the clerks office you may not be registered.**

**To avoid any problems at the polls Please call the town clerks office to verify your voting status.**

**Things to bring with you to the polls:**

**Reading glasses this is a two-sided ballot, candidates on one side and questions on the other.**

**Who needs to show id: a voter who registered by mail and who has not registered previously in MA.**

**Valid ID must contain name and address as registered.**

**Examples: driver's license, bank statement, Gov. check, utility bill, rent receipt on landlord's letterhead, etc.**

**Did you know: If you make a mistake on your ballot that's okay just inform one of the election tellers and you can get a new ballot.**

**Did you get the Information for Voters booklet on the 2014 Ballot Questions in the mail? If not you may pick up a booklet at the Town Hall Annex, or Town Hall located at the Senior Center. For your convenience there is a Voter Checklist in the back of the booklet that you may take to the polls.**

**Do you know what precinct you are? Not sure call the town clerk's office or look on the web site [www.granby-ma.gov](http://www.granby-ma.gov) under department of town clerk.**

**The polling location is the same for both precincts located at the East Meadow School in the cafeteria.**
