
### Single Stream Curbside Recycling Collection

A Single Stream Recycling Program allows residents the ability to combine **ALL Recyclables together in one container**



## Paper

- ◆ Newspaper with inserts
- ◆ Magazines / catalogs
- ◆ Phone books / office paper
- ◆ Junk mail, shredded paper, greeting cards, wrapping paper, paperbacks
- ◆ Chipboard, cereal, cracker boxes, etc.
- ◆ Corrugated cardboard
- ◆ Clean pizza boxes, No soiled paper, plastic bags or cardboard
- ◆ Aluminum foil (clean)



## Containers RINSE FIRST

- ◆ Glass bottles/jars No broken or other glass such as light bulbs, window or auto glass, dishes, glasses, Pyrex, Ceramics.
- ◆ Metal / Aluminum food & beverage cans, deposit and non-deposit cans, empty aerosol cans. No paint cans, or propane tanks.
- ◆ Plastic containers #1,2,3,5,6,7 (labeled on the bottom), jars, tubs, bottles, clear plastic hinged containers (clam shells), (health, beauty, food only), chemical containers.
- ◆ Milk, juice cartons and drink boxes

**NO: Styrofoam, eye glasses, light bulbs, batteries, flower pots, plastic cups & utensils, CD's & DVD's, hangers, pots or pans, miter oil / antifreeze containers, plastic trays or plastic bags**

**Solid Waste Collection:** Trash is picked up weekly and barrels or bags should be set out for pick up by 7AM. Granby's new Waste Reduction Program allows each household to place one barrel OR bag (volume 36-gallons/maximum weight 40 pounds) to be placed at the curbside **each week**. Additional/excess trash must be placed in a Town of Granby blue PAYT bag. Containers provided to residents from other waste haulers will not be collected. Trash exceeding the one (1) barrel/bag limit, and not placed in Town bags will not be collected.

**Where to Purchase Town Bags:** Official Town Bags Can be purchased at the following locations: **Town Hall, Big Y Store, 44 Willimansett St., Granby Country Grain, 108 West St.** Bags are sold in packs of five. 15 gallon - \$5.00 Per Pack, 33 gallon - \$10.00 Per Pack.

**Recycling:** Recycling is collected every other week, based on the street listing and calendar. You can use your own receptacle for recycling. There is no limit to the amount of materials you can recycle.

**Bulky Waste:** Bulky waste is picked up for a fee. Resident is to call Republic Services at 1-800-367-7778 to schedule a collection and make arrangements for payment. Bulky wastes is any item that cannot fit into a bag or barrel, such as furniture, appliances, lawn and garden equipment (gas tank removed and oil drained), etc. (check with Best Buy and Staples for free electronics recycling)

**Yard Waste Drop-Off Events:** There will be drop-off events in both the Spring and Fall. Dates will be posted on the Town's website, or call 1-800-367-7778 to inquire on the actual dates each season.

**Household Hazardous Waste Collection Event:** There will be a drop-off event for household hazardous waste. Date will be posted on the Town's website, or call 1-800-367-7778 to inquire on the actual date
