

Granby Clerk Reminders

Annual Census Information: Thank you, to all those who answer the 2018 Annual Census, second notices will be mailed out by February 1, 2018, to all those who did not respond to the first Annual Census mailing. To avoid any voting problems please mail back your census.

Compliance with this state requirement provides proof of residence, it protects voting rights, veteran's bonuses, housing for the elderly and related benefits.

The Annual Town Census does not register you as a voter or change your party enrollment. You must fill out a voter registration form or a change of enrollment card. For more information on voter registration please call the Town Clerks' office or check our website.

Dog Licenses: The Annual Census contains the First Notice for the 2018 dog licenses. Dog licenses are valid from April – April of each year however, if you wish to pre-register your dogs for 2018 please follow the instructions on the form and return with the census, or you may wait until March or April and stop by the office to license your dog. Please note that after May 1, 2018, a \$25.00 late charge may be applied along with the annual dog fee.
To Note: All those that pre-register their dogs will receive their dog license by March 31, 2018.

Voter Registration: *Are you a registered voter?*

If you are NOT a registered voter the last day to register to participate in the upcoming Special Town Meeting will be Monday, Feb. 5 from 9:00 am – 8 pm in the Town Clerks office.

To Note: The Special Town Meeting will be held on Tuesday, Feb. 13, 2018.

You may also pick up mail in voter registration forms at the Granby Post Office or the Granby Public Library, you can also download a voter registration form or register on-line go to www.sec.state.ma.us and search for voter registration, or our town website at www.granby-ma.gov and click on voter registration.

Mail in forms must be post marked by Feb. 5, 2018, to be eligible to participate

If you are not sure on your voter status please call the Town Clerk's office for verification.
